EAST BIXBY ROAD TO BE CLOSED EAST OF EBRIGHT ROAD TO US-33

Approximate closure dates: July 29, 2019 to August 16, 2019

Location: East Bixby Road, between Ebright Road and US-33

First address east of closure: US-33

Last address west of closure: 5225 Bixby Road

Please be advised it is anticipated that during the week of July 29, 2019, traffic patterns will change along Bixby Road as the road reconstruction project gets underway. Bixby Road from US 33 to Ebright Road will be CLOSED to allow for street reconstruction to occur. Detour route and signage will be put in place prior to the 29th, with detours beginning on July 30, 2019.

The City's contractor, Strawser Paving Company, will be mobilizing equipment as road work begins on the project. During construction, the road will be closed to through traffic. Local traffic will be permitted to access their homes. ALL OTHER TRAFFIC must use the posted detour route (see reverse).

Through traffic travelers wishing to go east-bound on Bixby Road from Ebright Road will not be allowed to pass through the construction zone. Travelers wishing to turn left from northwest-bound US 33 will NOT be able to turn left at Bixby Road. Follow posted detour signs.

During critical weeks of construction, the roadway between US 33 and Ebright Road will be temporarily closed to through traffic. Residents residing in the Harriet Subdivision (homes on Solomon Avenue, Harriet Street, Stoltz Avenue, Ginger Court, and Morgan Court), will not be permitted to access their properties from Bixby Road, and should access these streets from the Ebright Road/Solomon Avenue intersection, following posted detours. Area residents should avoid the Work Zone and use the detour.

Within the construction zone, mail delivery, trash collection and emergency services will be continued.

It is expected that the Contractor will begin activities related to the project in late July 2019. Weather permitting, work should be complete by mid-October, 2019.
