The City of Groveport manages a stormwater program in accordance with its Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System Permit (also known as a MS4 permit) issued by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency.

Recent Activities – January through March, 2020

- Monthly inspections were conducted at 2 construction sites covered under the Ohio EPA Construction General Permit for stormwater related discharges (Startech and Hickory Grove);
- A quarterly Stormwater Inspection was conducted at the City Maintenance Facility;
- Four stormwater pollution prevention plans were reviewed and approved for construction. They include Thornton's, Eastland Career Center, CMH Logistics and Bluestone Development;
- Follow the River Environmental, in conjunction with the City, completed the 2019 Annual MS4 Report and submitted it to the Ohio EPA in March; and
- A total of seventy six (76) Post Construction Best Management Practices (BMPs) letters were mailed out to businesses in March. These included 36 to sites constructed prior to 2003, 27 to sites constructed between 2003 and 2011 and 13 to sites constructed after 2011.

Recent Activities – April through June, 2020

- In April inspections were conducted at 3 construction sites covered under the Ohio EPA Construction General Permit for stormwater related discharges (Startech, Eastland Fairfield Career Center and Hickory Grove); In May inspections were conducted at 5 construction sites included a final inspection at AEP Learning Center and an initial inspection at Saltzgaber Mass Grading site; In June inspections were conducted at the 4 above mentioned active sites;
- A quarterly Stormwater Inspection was conducted at the City Maintenance Facility;
- Two stormwater pollution prevention plans were reviewed. The Saltzgaber Mass Grading site was approved for construction. The AEP Station Site (Bixby Road) was issued a notice of deficiency;

Recent Activities – July through September, 2020

- In July inspections were conducted at 4 construction sites covered under the Ohio EPA Construction General Permit for stormwater related discharges (Startech, Eastland Fairfield Career Center, Hickory Grove Phase 3 and Saltzgaber Mass Grading). In August there were also 4 construction sites inspected for stormwater related discharges (Startech, Eastland Fairfield Career Center, Hickory Grove Phase 3 and Saltzgaber Hemmer). In September each of the 4 above mentioned sites were again inspected for stormwater related discharges. In addition, a Pre-Construction Meeting was held in August for the Saltzgaber Hemmer Development Project;

- A quarterly Stormwater Inspection was conducted at the City Maintenance Facility;

- Two stormwater pollution prevention plans and operation and maintenance plans were approved in September. They are the Port Road Development Project and the Redwood Development Project.

Bedrock Earthworks stormwater pollution prevention plan was also approved in September.

Recent Activities – October through December, 2020

- In October inspections were conducted at 4 construction sites covered under the Ohio EPA Construction General Permit for stormwater related discharges (Startech, Eastland Fairfield Career Center, Hickory Grove Phase 3 and Saltzgaber Mass Grading). In November there were also 4 construction sites inspected for stormwater related discharges (Startech, Eastland Fairfield Career Center, Hickory Grove Phase 3 and Saltzgaber Hemmer). In December 3 construction sites were inspected for stormwater related discharges (Startech, Eastland Fairfield Career Center and Saltzgaber);
- A quarterly Stormwater Inspection was conducted at the City Maintenance Facility;
- On November 17, 2020 a new Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan was submitted for review;
- Follow the River Environmental conducted an annual training presentation on good housekeeping, pollution prevention, and spill prevention for 12 municipal employees via the Web;
- Fall leaf collection was ongoing from October through the middle of December.
