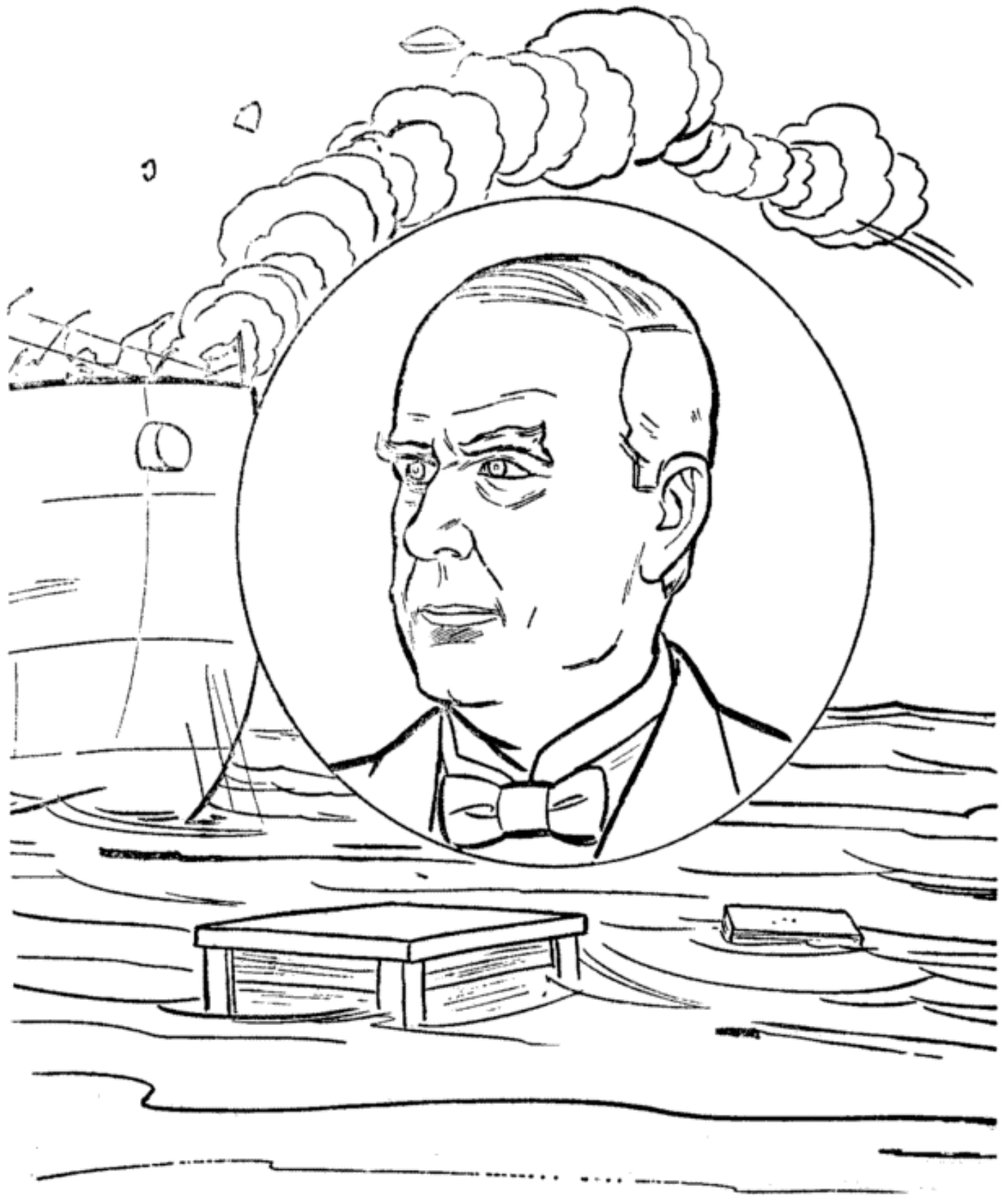




William Howard Taft was President from 1909-1913. In 1921 he became Chief Justice of the Supreme Court, the only man to hold both of these high offices.



After winning many victories and earning the nickname "Unconditional Surrender Grant," Ulysses S. Grant was given supreme command of the Union forces.



William McKinley, 25th President (1897-1901)

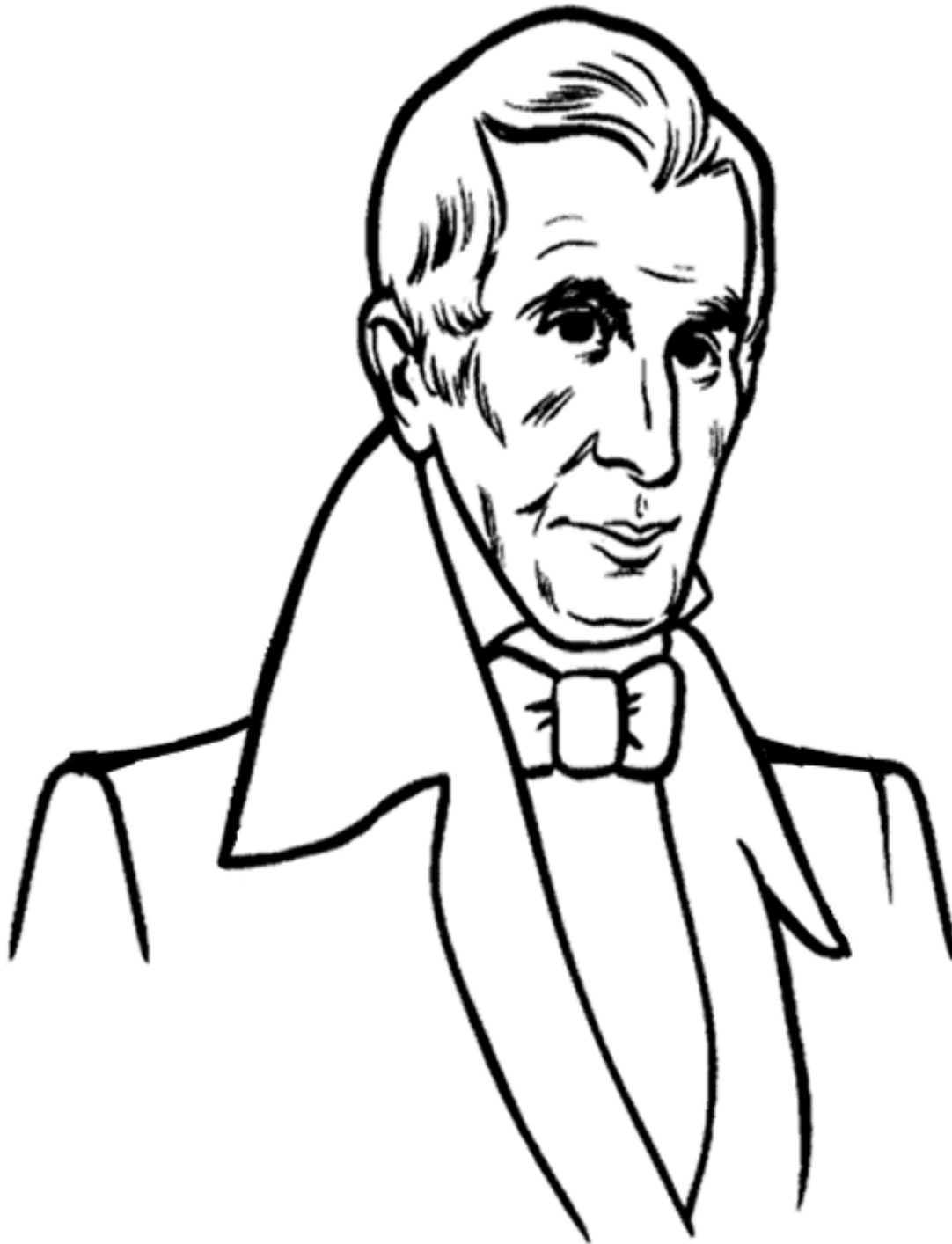


Benjamin Harrison Term of Office: 1889-1893

On August 20, 1833, Benjamin Harrison, 23rd president of the United States, was born in North Bend, Ohio. His great-grandfather signed the Declaration of Independence and his grandfather was president. During his presidency the first game of basketball was invented. The total number of states was 44 at that time. Benjamin Harrison died on March 13, 1901 in Indianapolis, Indiana.

When William Henry Harrison died one month after taking office in 1841, he was succeeded by Vice-President John Tyler.



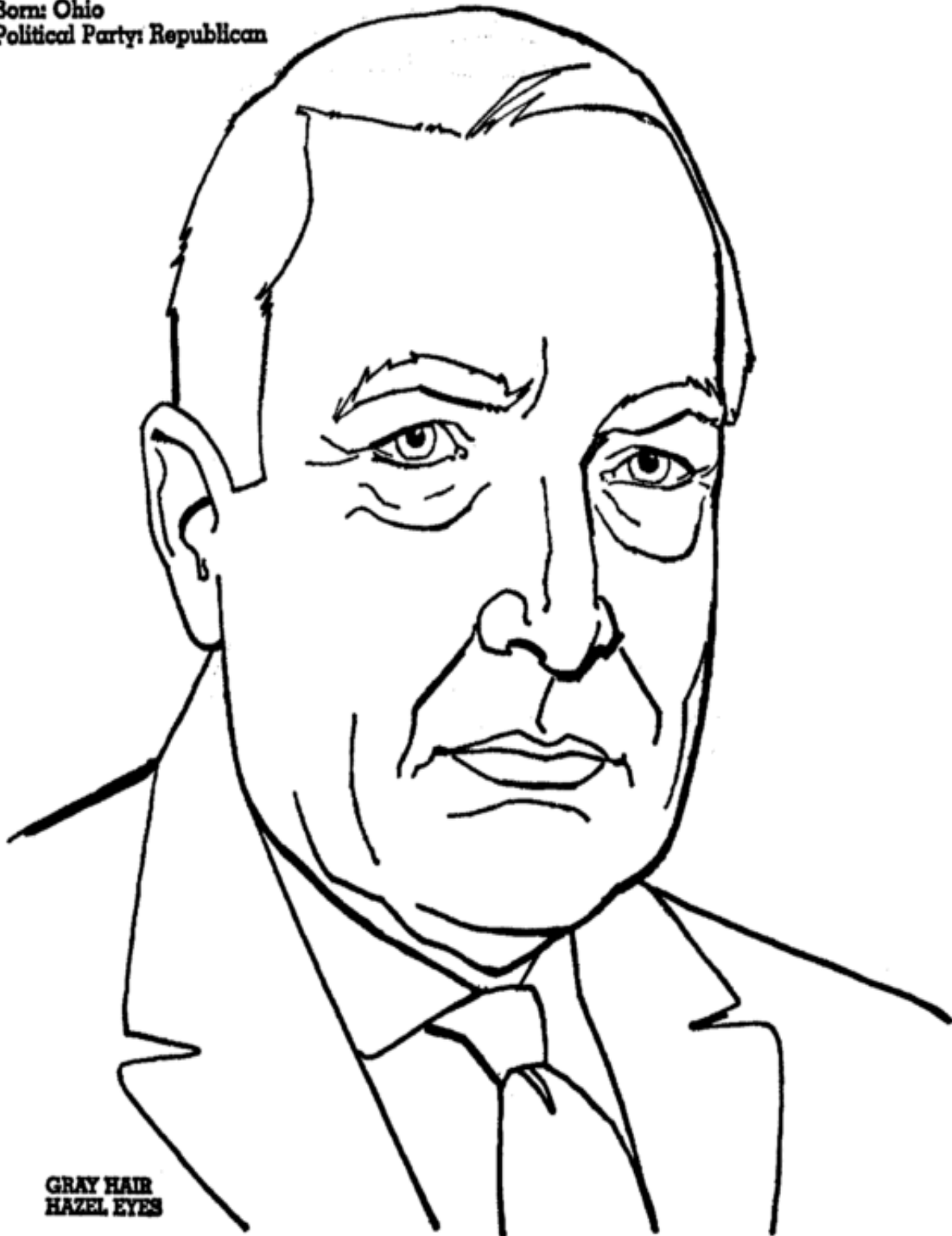
The last President to go from log cabin to White House was James A. Garfield. He was fatally shot by a disappointed office seeker after less than four months in office.

"Back to Normalcy" was the slogan of President Warren G. Harding. During his administration the people of the United States hoped to return to the life they had enjoyed before World War I. The severe depression of 1921 was harmful to the popularity of Harding's administration.

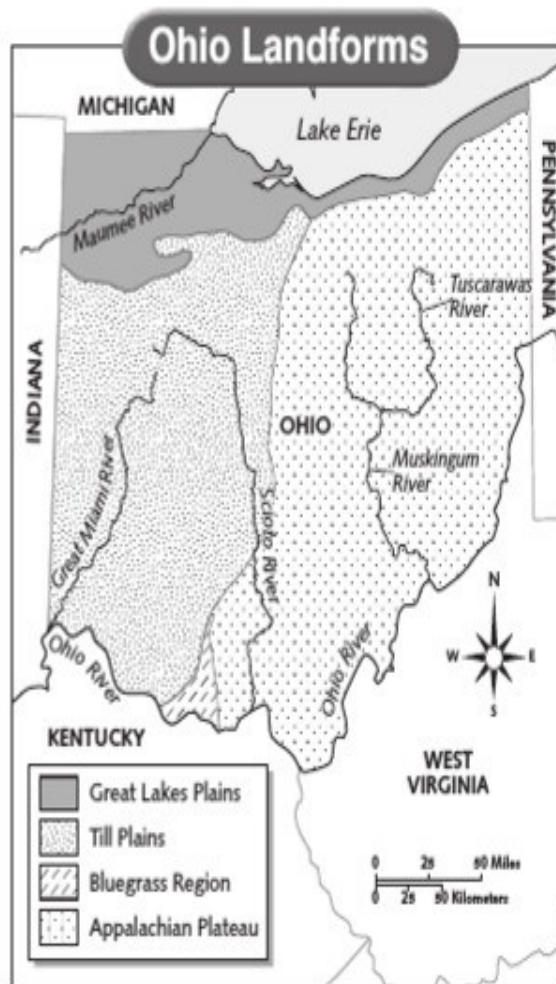

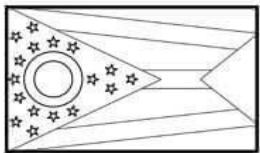
2 Which physical feature forms Ohio's border on the south and east?
